This office has reviewed the above-mentioned report, which has been submitted to this ministry as a condition of licensing in accordance with Part VI of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c 0.18.¹ This review has been carried out in order to determine whether the licensed professional consultant archaeologist has met the terms and conditions of their licence, that the licensee assessed the property and documented archaeological resources using a process that accords with the 2011 *Standards and Guidelines for Consultant Archaeologists* set by the ministry, and that the archaeological fieldwork and report recommendations are consistent with the conservation, protection and preservation of the cultural heritage of Ontario.

The report documents the assessment/mitigation of the study area as depicted in Map 5 and Map 6 of the above titled report and recommends the following:

Additional lands were acquired by the proponent and incorporated into the application subsequent to the initial submission of this report. These additional lands were assessed under PIF #P038-1006-2020 and filed with MHSTCI under separate cover. As a result of the Stage 2 Property Assessment of the study area addressed within this report, no archaeological resources were encountered. Consequently, the following recommendations are made:

1. The area subject to Stage 2 Property Assessment in this report under PIF #P058-1726-2018 is clear of archaeological concerns.
2. The proposed undertaking is not clear of archaeological concern until MHSTCI accepts the report addressing that portion of the proposed undertaking reported under PIF # P038-1006-2020 into the

Provincial Registry of Archaeological Reports.

Based on the information contained in the report, the ministry is satisfied that the fieldwork and reporting for the archaeological assessment are consistent with the ministry's 2011 *Standards and Guidelines for Consultant Archaeologists* and the terms and conditions for archaeological licences. This report has been entered into the Ontario Public Register of Archaeological Reports.
