## 2026 BUDGET

On December 3, 2025 Council passed the 2026 budget, which included \$15,000 towards road safety measures and \$7,500 towards Mulmur's 175th Anniversary. 2026 Capital Projects include:

- Bridge 11 replacement on the Mulmur-Tosorontio Townline
- Road resurfacing
- Snowplow replacement
- Arena Chiller replacement
- Donation of a pickleball multipurpose court in Terra Nova

The tax rate increase is 3.35%, which is only 0.95% higher than inflation. This increase equals \$19.51 per \$100,000 of residential assessment, or approximately \$104.75 per year for the average household.

## TAXES

### How are my property taxes calculated?

The Municipal Property Assessment Corporation (MPAC) is responsible for assessing all property values in Mulmur, which is then multiplied by the Township, County and education tax rates. To learn more about your assessment, call MPAC at **1-866-296-6722** or visit [mpac.ca](http://mpac.ca).

### Penalty and Interest:

Penalty and interest is applied at the rate of 1.25% per month on all outstanding amounts. Please ensure all online payments are made at least 3-5 days before they are due to avoid any penalty and interest.

### Payment Options:

**Pre-Authorized Payments:** Set up a monthly or instalment-based plan.

**Online or Telephone Banking:** Pay through your financial institution's website, banking app, or automated phone service.

**In Person, Drop Box, or Mail:** Mail your payment or visit us in person to pay by cash, cheque, debit, or to use the secure drop box. Cheques should be made payable to the Township of Mulmur. Post-dated cheques are also accepted.
