Honeywood Hockeyville Equipment Loan Program (Honeywood HELP)

Terms and Conditions of Loan

1. The Township of Mulmur will lend the equipment to the borrower on the terms and conditions of this agreement.
2. The equipment shall be loaned from _____ until _____
3. The loan period may be extended by mutual consent of both parties.

Collection and Delivery of Equipment

1. The borrower must arrange a mutually convenient time to collect the equipment on the first day of the loan period and to return it on the last day of the loan period.
2. The equipment loaned to the borrower shall not be considered as returned until it is verified and signed in by the Township of Mulmur.

Title and Risk

1. The borrower acknowledges that they have no right, title, or property in the equipment.
2. Risk of any loss or damage to the equipment is the responsibility of the borrower until the equipment is returned to the Township of Mulmur.
3. The borrower is responsible for any liability related to the use of the loaned equipment while it is in their possession.
4. The borrower acknowledges that the Township of Mulmur has not checked the equipment to ensure that it is fit for purpose or in compliance with necessary regulations prior to use.

Borrower Responsibilities

The borrower agrees that during the loan period, they shall:

1. Keep the equipment in their possession and ensure that it is secured against loss, damage, or theft.
2. Operate the equipment in accordance with any operating instructions issued for it and for the purpose it was designed.

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3. Keep the equipment in good working order.
4. The equipment shall not be modified.
5. The equipment should be appropriately cleaned prior to the end of the loan period by the borrower following its use. Borrower will be liable for any cleaning costs incurred by the Township of Mulmur related to the loaned equipment.

Replacement of Damaged or Lost Equipment

In the event of the equipment being lost or damaged by cause outside of regular use, the borrower agrees to pay the replacement cost as indicated below.
